



## CHATEAU VALENTIN 2014

Conditions were excellent in the spring enabling good. Uniform flowering.

The summer proved to be a little more difficult, but was not detrimental to the harvest. The real summer seemed to arrive late, September and October with exceptional sunny enabling us to obtain ripe, concentrated grapes.

The harvest began on 30 SEPTEMBER and finished on 17 October

The Blend of château Valentin 2014 is 43% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 37% PETIT VERDOT ET 20% MERLOT

History of Chateau Valentin: where does the name come from? CHATEAU VALENTIN is a surname of a first owner of chateau Deyrem Valentin in 1776. We have bought the vineyard come from Avensan Village, because our grandfather was born to this village. But we sought a quality Terroir; we found it with old Petit Verdot which are over 80 years old in 2001.

We expanded the vineyard from Soussans village just beside a vine of Margaux Appellation.
