


CHATEAU DEYREM VALENTIN 2017



My great-grandfather used to say that "all the great terroirs face the estuary". And in the spring of 2017, the estuary protected us, saving the vines from any damage from the terrible frosts, since Château Deyrem Valentin's vineyard lies on a gravel hilltop overlooking and running alongside the Garonne river.

Thanks to the good weather conditions, flowering and veraison were uniform and fast for all grape varieties. A little rain at the beginning of September accelerated the ripening process. We harvested the first Merlot on 21 September, followed by the Cabernet Sauvignon on 2 October.

The fermentations went well, and we opted for a delicate extraction, with no more than gentle racking.

Blending is carried out after malolactic fermentation, and the wine is then transferred to barrels, to age for a year.

Deyrem Valentin 2017 is refined, with delicate, flavourful tannins, and a pleasant aromatic complexity.

Blend: 50% MERLOT, 50% CABERNET SAUVIGNON
